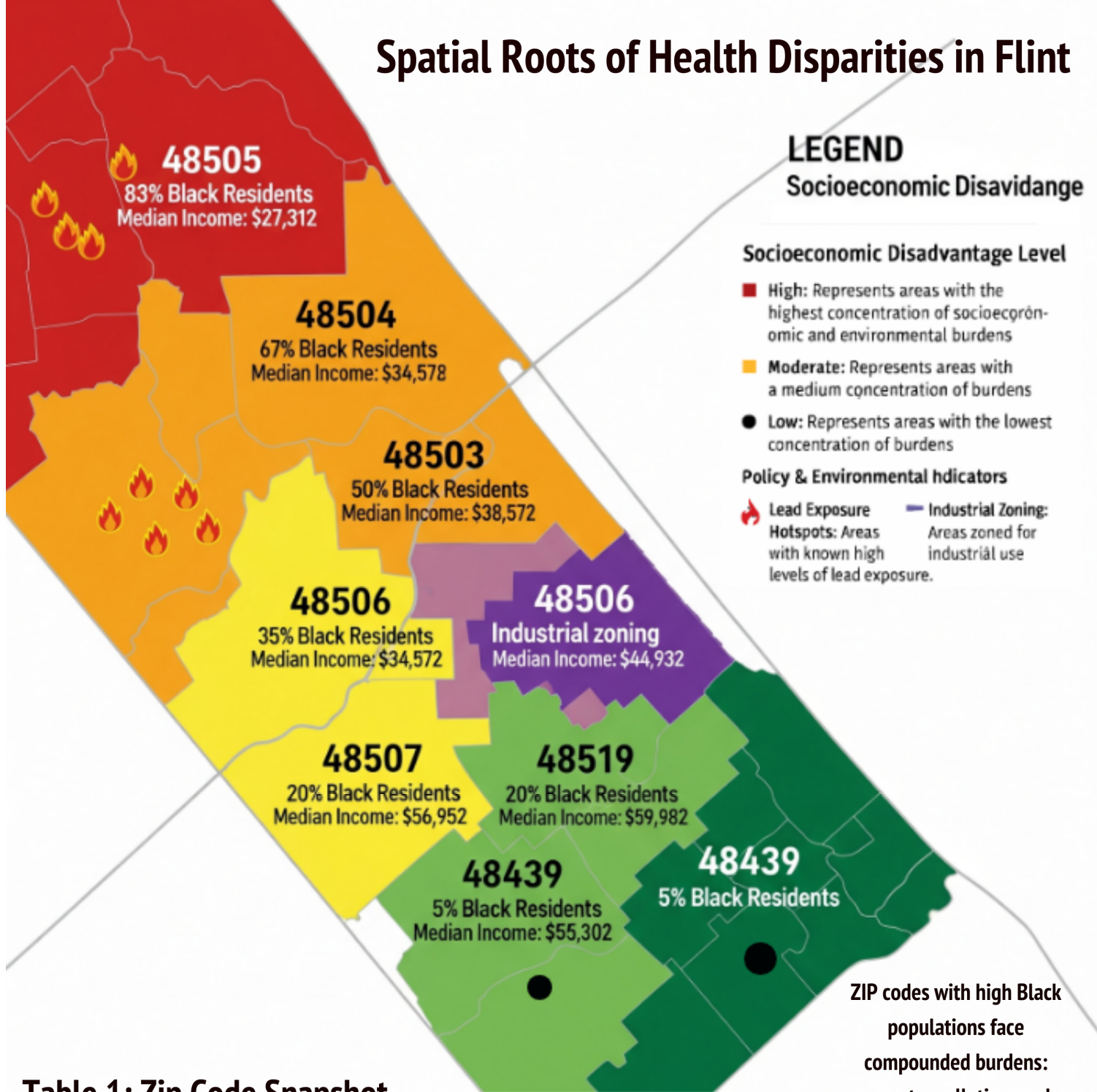


Table 1: Zip Code Snapshot

48506	51%	\$30,212	High	Industrial Zoning
48439	8%	\$85,551	Lowest	None

ZIP codes with high Black populations face compounded burdens: poverty, pollution, and poor health outcomes - Statistical analysis confirms significant racial disparities in income, home value, unemployment, and access to healthcare

What This Map Reveals?

This heat map visualizes Flint’s ZIP-coded disparities in race, income, and environmental risk.

- Red zones (e.g., 48505): High % Black residents, low income, lead exposure, industrial zoning
- Green zones (e.g., 48439): Low % Black residents, high income, minimal environmental burden
